

Traffic Incident Management

<u>Description</u> — Three injury crashes occur every minute in the United States, putting nearly 39,000 incident responders potentially in harm's way every day. This new national training program is building a cadre of well-trained responders who can work together as a team in a coordinated manner, from the moment the first emergency call is made, to the correct deployment of response vehicles and equipment, to a safe work area using traffic control devices, to final scene clearance. TIM consists of a planned and coordinated multidisciplinary process to detect, respond to, and clear traffic incidents so that traffic flow may be restored quickly.
