

EMPHASIS AREA: INTERSECTIONS

GULF COAST VISION ZERO ACTION PLAN

Through a partnership between the Mississippi Department of Transportation (MDOT) and Gulf Regional Planning Commission (GRPC), a Local Road Safety Plan was completed that analyzed crash data to identify intersections with safety concerns. Through this partnership, crash data was analyzed across Hancock, Harrison, and Jackson counties. Emphasis areas were identified, and stakeholders were convened to gather input. Countermeasures were identified to reduce and prevent future crashes.

In 2023 a supplemental planning analysis was completed to make the LRSP meet the criteria established for the SS4A Action Plan.

Crash data from 2019-2022 was analyzed to identify intersections that are experiencing high rates of severe crashes. Using GIS software, fatal and injury crash rates were identified for each intersection in the three county planning area. The intersections with the highest crash rates were identified as high-risk intersections.

The Mississippi Gulf Coast region has an eligible Action Plan in place to apply for Implementation Grants from USDOT's Safe Streets and Roads for All (SS4A) grant program.

OBJECTIVE

Reduce motor vehicle crash fatalities and serious injuries

STRATEGY

Evaluating and improving the safety of intersections system-wide by considering innovative design changes, improved delineation, advanced warning, roundabouts, and pedestrian crossing improvements.

MEASURE

Number of serious injury and fatality crashes

Rate of serious injury and fatality crashes per 100 million VMT

SAFETY COUNTERMEASURES

When two or more roads cross at intersections, vehicles, pedestrians, and bicyclists cross paths, which can result in many different crash types. Not all intersection crashes offer the potential for a fatal or serious injury crash. As a result, the strategies to prevent or minimize intersection crashes focus on reducing or eliminating the conflicts that most frequently contributed to severe crashes and consider all modes of travel, including pedestrians and bicyclists Possible countermeasures that would eliminate or mitigate identified safety concerns were identified based on the crash types that were occurring.

- Traffic control and operational improvements
- Signage, Advanced warning
- Geometric improvements
- Mast arms
- Signal backing plates
- Sight distances at signalized intersections
- Driver awareness of intersections and signal control
- Left and right turn lanes
- Corridor access management
- Reduced left—turn conflict intersections
- Appropriately timed yellow change interval
- Roundabouts
- J-turn
